Quantock class also had an amazing time at Axminster Gymnastics centre on Tuesday morning and are already looking forward to returning next week.



YouTube Kids is a child-friendly version of YouTube which offers a colourful and easy-to-navigate environment that's suitable for young children. This app is easily accessible and available for mobile devices, which can be downloaded without needing the YouTube opp on the device. Despite YouTube Kids seeming like a very child-friendly platform, it has raised concerns over its advertising and inappropriate content seeping through the curation process.

Download the YouTube Kids app and connect your own YouTube channel.

SETTING

Select the types of videos you want to include for your child based on their age and your own personal choice.

If you decide to approve the content yourself, the app will present you with sample videos for you to accept and reject.

Once you've made your choice, you're ready to use the app!



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REMOVE ADVERTISEMENTS
