

English:

We will be writing a finding tale based on the Storm Whale and a set of instructions based on Izzy Gizmo.

Year 1 Maths:

We will be focusing on counting to 20, representing numbers, comparing, and ordering.

Year 2 Maths:

We will be learning about the place value of 2-digit numbers, representing numbers, comparing and ordering.

Science: Everyday Materials

We will be identifying and materials and we will be learning about the difference between a material and an object. We will test the absorbency of different materials and whether they would be suitable for making an umbrella. We will learn the terms, transparent and opaque. Finally we will look at how we can changed the shape of different materials by twisting, stretching, squashing and squeezing.
